



Pre-rental Checklist

- Check the local licence laws/ have IDP ready

- Check with your insurance company for policy exclusions

- Look through reviews to find a trustworthy company.

- Negotiate the price of the rental for weekly/monthly rates

- Check the tires for wear, cracks, grip and inflation level

- Test the front and rear brakes
Tip: they shouldn't make a noise, and should jolt to a stop

- Check the headlights and indicators work, and record the petrol

- Choose a helmet- preferably a full face with a clear visor
Note: it shouldn't have any cracks/dents

- Manual Motorbikes*: check the clutch and the gears

- Take photos and videos of ALL parts of the motorbike
Tip: take them in the sunlight

- Read the rental agreement- check all details are accurate
NOTE: See if they provide any insurance with the bike

- Leave a cash deposit- do NOT leave your passport

- Sign the agreement and take a photo of the document

- Record the company's number to contact in emergencies

- Ride away 😊
